We hope that this will give the candidates an opportunity to inform the audience on their proposed policies and for the Italian community in London to raise any questions which concern them.

The Parliamentary Candidates participating in the debate will be the following:

Marcello Urbani – candidate for the Senate - FARE per fermare il declino

Marcello Urbani is a candidate for the Senate for Fare per fermare il declino. He was born in Brescia, Lombardia. He attended the engineering school 'politecnico' in Milan. At the age of 38, he decided to leave Italy and moved to Gent, Belgium and then London. He has been living in the UK capital city for three years.

Guglielmo Picchi - candidate to the Camera – il Popolo della Liberta'

Guglielmo Picchi graduated in Business at the University of Florence and with a Master of Business Administration from the SDA Bocconi Business school in Milan and contributed to the founding of the Forza Italia party in Tuscany in 1993. Picchi was elected to the City council of Florence then moved to London to work for a British investment bank. In 2006, he was elected for the first time to the Italian parliament in the European overseas constituency where member of the foreign affairs committee. In 2008 he was re-elected in the same constituency and has been a member of the Italian Parliamentary delegation to the Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe.

LUIGI BILLE - candidate to the Senata - "Con MONTI PER L'ITALIA"

Luigi Bille is an architect who has lived in London since 1996. He was President of the Parents Association of the Italian School at Kings Cross. He was also national coordinator of Movimento Associativo Italiani all'estero.

Andrea Biondi- candidate to the Camera - Partito Democratico

Professor of European Union Law and the Co-Director of the Centre for European Law at King's College London. He is a visiting professor at the College of Europe in Warsaw, Georgetown University Universidade Católica Portuguesa of Lisbon. He is a member of the Bar of Florence as well as being an Academic Member of Francis Taylor Buildings Chambers in London. He was elected secretary of PD London, which he funded in 2009.
